### Agricultural/ Domestic /Combined

General Overall Appearance, Theme, Bible & Flag, labeling worth up to 200 points

**Agricultural** Fresh Vegetables & Fruit worth up to 50 points each category. Canned fruit and Vegetables, pickles, relishes, Jams, jellies worth up to 40 points each category. Other canned items worth up to 10 points. Dairy products (representation) and eggs worth up to 20 points each category. Honey, Maple Syrup, Herbs, Grains. Grasses and other agricultural items worth up to 30 points each category. Quality and appearance worth up to 100 points

**Domestic:** Knitted, Crocheted and Sewn Items, Needlework other, Quilts and Quilted Items and Wood Crafted Items worth up to 50 points each category. Miscellaneous Crafted items and a Bonus of Outstanding Workmanship worth up to 100 points each category.
