- All sheep must be owned by exhibitor
- ALL LIVESTOCK will be inspected by the Veterinarian on site upon arrival prior to unloading.
- Open to York County and Cumberland County residents.
- All sheep must be ear tagged or tattooed with State I.D.
- Rams must be registered and the registration papers must be on the fairgrounds.
- Sheep must be on the fairgrounds by 8:30 AM Thursday and remain until released at 5 PM Sunday, in order to receive premium checks.
- Two entries per Division per exhibitor may be shown, except in group Divisions, the limit is one breed per farm.
- Judging will begin on the completion of the 4-H Goat Judging.
